## THEME ETHNIC FESTIVAL: CONNECT AND PRESERVE THE IDENTITY

The North East Christian University (NECU) is organizing its 4th Naga Culture Symposium from 2nd December- 3rd December 2022. As a complementary to the Hornbill Festival, an annual Naga culture festival, the symposium aims to showcase the rich Naga cultural and artistic traditions; and, to engage in various discourses on the subject that is significantly emerging in the academia or intellectual space. The overarching themes are based on the socio-cultural rubrics, which will serve as a framework for the participants to discuss the diverse underlying themes. The sessions are designed for the presenters and the participants to engage with their ideas and perspectives on the subject, followed by a workshop on the application of the various Naga traditional artistic techniques.

**DAY ONE:** The sessions will focus on the experts and the scholars exploring their key ideas, extending to various sub-themes: folklore and oral history; the legacies of the past and its historical root; religion, myths, and consciousness; and, migrations. Multidisciplinary approaches beyond the aforementioned themes are also encouraged.

**DAY TWO:** An exclusive workshop to explore the Naga artistic traditions will be the session's main focus. It will involve the participants in acquiring knowledge and skills such as traditional wood carvings, traditional musical instruments, weaving, and other handicrafts using different local mediums and materials.

For selected papers, the authors are requested to follow the APA citation style, and the full manuscript should not exceed 3,500 words (including notes and references). Authors must ensure originality in writing scholarly papers and avoid plagiarism. Selected papers will be published preceding the Symposium as anthology books with an International Standard Book Number (ISBN)
