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ONSITE SURVEILLANCE ASSESSMENT- JORHAT, ASSAM

The North East Christian University (NECU) at Dimapur, Nagaland was established through the North East Christian University Act 2012 passed by the Nagaland State Legislative. This was duly notified in the State Gazette in 2013. As per the University Grants Commission Act, NECU is empowered to confer degrees in subjects as per the recognized list of degrees notified by the UGC. These range from UG to PhD degrees. The University may on its own also issue Certificates and Diplomas in different teaching - training programmes, which can range from one day to a few years' duration.

NECU has been accorded the Provisional Approval as a Personnel Certification Body for the Certification of Traditional Community Healthcare Providers (TCHP) by the scheme owner, Quality Council of India, vide QCI/TCHP/PrCB-002 dated 18th October 2018 for VCSTCHP for the following Scope:

1. Jaundice
2. Common Ailments (CA)
3. Traditional Bone Setting (TBS)
4. Rheumatoid Arthritis
5. Poisonous Bites (PB)
6. Traditional Birth Attendant (TBA) (This additional scope was added via QCI/TCHP/PrCB-002 dated 19th September 2019)

NECU's objective as a Personnel Certification Body for TCHPs, is to recognize TCHPs through an internationally recognized system of assessment. TCHPs found competent for their knowledge and skill in the specific domain of practice and have been rendering effective healthcare services to society are being certified. NECU is implementing the VCSTCHP with the objective of achieving and promoting a globally accepted benchmark for certification of persons. TCHP certification is the path to providing assurance for quality traditional healthcare services for the 6 domains. Till date 49 TCHPs have been certified for the 4 cycles of certification already conducted in the states of Tripura, Assam and Nagaland-Dimapur and Tuensang and Manipur.

The Procedure Manual (PM) of the Scheme Voluntary Certification Scheme for Traditional Community Healthcare Providers (VCSTCHPs) prescribes PM Cl. 4.4.1 NECU will conduct an onsite assessment once in a certification cycle for each certified TCHP. This will be done during latter half of third year since the grant of certificate. Accordingly, the Onsite Surveillance Assessment for the Certified TCHPs from Jorhat, Assam was held on 11th and 12th May 2022.

Since, the PM has not specified any procedure for the conduct of the Onsite Surveillance Assessment, after due consultation with NACCB, the Quality Manager of NECU PrCB PR 006 was proposed as the Evaluator for the Onsite Surveillance Assessment.

All the 15 Certified TCHPs has already undergone the three levels of Evaluation- Oral Interview followed by Demonstration and Onsite Field Assessment during the Certification Process. Therefore, the main objective of the Onsite Surveillance was to verify:

- a. whether there is any change in the address and contact nos. of the TCHPs
- b. whether they were maintaining Patients' Record
- c. whether hygiene is maintained in their workstation and also with the storage of prepared medicine
- d. whether they had received any complaints from any patients
- e. whether they were engaging themselves in any community healthcare activities
- f. whether they were abiding by the Certificate Criterion

The 15 TCHPs from Jorhat, Assam were certified on 18th June 2019 for the period of five years. Their certificates are valid upto 17th June 2024. They were certified in the following domains:

- a. Arthritis
- b. Common Ailments
- c. Jaundice
